1. Cancellation of Joint Subcommittee meeting scheduled for March 1st at 10am.
2. Learning Institute Updates
 - a. The event appears to be youth oriented and focused this year – Corey gave an update on youth activities and events planned.
 - i. Key note, Johanna Burgan, Executive Director of Youth Move National.

 - b. Wednesday will focus on Trauma Informed Care and is sponsored by BHARP System of Care Project.
 - c. Evaluation Subcommittee Proposal submitted – “Connecting the Data Dots from Trauma to Hope”
 - i. Goals
 1. Understanding Trauma

2. How to use data and capture data related to Trauma
 3. How to use the data to work on outcomes.
 - ii. 38 proposals have been submitted, unknown which ones are approved.
 - d. Evaluation Subcommittee Meeting on June 20th at State College from 3-5pm – how many of you will be there?
 - i. Mark, Maria, Bryon, Gordon, Andy, Alan (probable), Amanda, Corey, Monica, and Will are planning to attend.
 - e. SOC Data brochure feedback (attached) – do we still want to work on this and distribute?
 - i. This relates to the Joint Subcommittee data and meetings with them which have been postponed; however, we would still like to offer some data brochures for distribution
 - ii. Two Page Flyer reviewed
 1. Comment, may have a little too much information, but is it is easy to understand.
 2. Add statement: Pennsylvania’s goal for System of Care is to address the needs of youth and family and help child serving systems on a local level function better. (Check the Mission/Vision of SOC for wording and make sure it covers both individual and system level.)
 3. Make sure to clarify % to detail if % of whole or subgroup.
 4. Suggested adding citations to the end, and remove from middle of page.
 5. Make fonts in the SOC definition all the same.
 6. Should there more to explain what SOC is, and would this need to be a totally separate form.
 - a. Could add a small piece to find out more go to _____ (website and contact info)
 7. 2nd page, make all left justified.
 - a. Information under the 8 standards, relate to responses from the County Assessment.
 - b. Suggested to either merge boxes or modify color and font.
 - c. Reframe title of 8 standards of PA System of Care
 - i. Could be “How are PA Counties working on the 8 Standards of PA System of Care”
 - d. Integration of Child Serving Systems= Could change symbol to venn diagram or puzzle
 - e. Family Driven- Could use stick figure drawing of family.
 - f. Can use updated 2016 data if ready in time
 - iii. County Assessment is translated into Spanish and Will is working on formatting into software programs.
3. Any feedback from the distribution of the other reports (county/state coaching and descriptive reports) to HFW counties?
 - a. Mark made comment that funding source information in the descriptive reports may be in error as it was noted in York that it was HealthChoices Funded, when it was Reinvestment funded.
 - b. Also noted that on the Coaches report, there was issue that the Coach time not reported, but kept internally in supervision notes.
 - i. YFTI continues to work on this.
4. Healthy Transitions
 - a. Changes to data requirements from SAMHSA
 - i. This does not affect HFW counties only Healthy Transitions Counties and SOC Expansion Grant counties.
 - ii. Trac-Noms replaced by Common Data Platform (CDP) and Data Collection Instrument (DCI)

1. The new site CDP, did not work and SAMHSA asked to go back to Trac forms.
 - a. This will result in mass changes in data reporting.
 - b. YFTI, had in their forms data needed for the Trac-Noms, so changes should not impact the counties greatly.
 - i. YFTI will extract the data needed by SAMHSA and enter into TRAC system.
 - ii. Perception of Care and satisfaction and quality of services added as well as what services receiving.
 - b. First draft of the Descriptive Data report for Healthy Transitions!!
 - i. Please take a look and give us feedback on the format and way that we are representing the data.
 - ii. Check for any spelling/errors in calculations/etc. too!
 - iii. We appreciate all feedback as this is our first review of the report with anyone – and please keep it confidential!
 1. Youth Traumatic Experience- Number of PTSD symptoms- Add “Symptoms” next to the number.
 - a. According to the DSM V a person must have all four symptoms to be diagnosed with PTSD.
 - b. Consider summarizing symptoms for the Depression section too
 - c. Are multi-system youth being enrolled into HT?
 - d. Why are youth not attending 100% of the planning meetings?
 - e. Will discuss these issues on Peer-to-Peer call with HT counties.
