 the survey as several people got it more than once and it wasn't clear that it was the
 same thing.
 - We need to add the "no-wrong door" question back in for next year. Delaware County's CLT will be helping to draft the question
- 2. SOC Data brochure (final draft) This incorporates the suggestions from last time about adding HFW info to footnote
 - **a.** We will update with this year's County Assessment data asap and Monica will have it printed on professional glossy paper from the Pitt print shop.
 - **b.** Plan to distribute at the Learning Institute with everyone's registration info and at the Evaluation Subcommittee workshops on June 22nd.

 - i. Discuss agenda and how to incorporate guests who may attend

 - We will present the same 5-min welcome/orientation to our work that we will use for the Shannon/Sherry meeting to help orient guests.

- We will focus on strategic planning for the next year
- We will run the meeting like a HFW meeting maybe ask Maria to facilitate since the other members will be at the HFW sessions?
- Joint Subcommittee meeting with the CLC subcommittee Tuesday, June 21 (8:30-9:15am)
 - i. This includes a breakfast buffet to thank everyone for your commitment to the work! Come hungry!
 - ii. We need a brief presentation to review with the directors of the OMHSAS Children's Bureau and Policy Department
 - We will make a one-page handout of our accomplishments and the tri-chairs will present it along with any other members who can give input
 - iii. What questions should we ask them?!
 - Brainstormed list of questions:
 - What is the consistent message that we want to get out with our data?
 - How can we connect all of our grants and HFW in our data dissemination?
 - How do we connect our data to other grants that we are not directly related to – Safe Schools/Healthy Students and Project Launch
 - What is the mechanism by which we can give and receive input to decision makers?
 - We wonder if the right people are being served by the grants – how can we get the data that are relevant and how/to whom will we provide input?
 - o What is our connection to the SLMT?
 - How do we build the cost of data collection and dissemination (data infrastructure) into budgets of systems and providers so that they have the time and resources to do quality work in this area?
 - Same question for interpreter service and special services for deaf/hard of hearing, etc.
 - What are the barriers and how can we address them?
 - How can we work toward an integrated database of child (and adult) serving systems?
 - How do counties fund and sustain all of the work from the grants and for other services?
 - How might data play a role in this?
 - How can we start to address the disparity between HFW and other family/youth driven planning processes and the BHRS (general way of doing business) so that youth and families receive comparable care no matter what county they are in or what services/supports they have?
 - How can data play a role in this?
