





and between complex systems






Through FMR training, parents/primary caregivers gain skills and knowledge

- Break up complicated problems into tasks they can handle
- Decode unfamiliar language and confusing procedures.
- Work effectively with providers to ensure their children and youth receive the best care.






Family Road Map Curricula

- **Family Road Map** workshop: interactive, team-based, six instructional hours, implemented in one or multiple sessions
- **FRM Guiding Star** support groups/small groups; works well one chapter per session
- **FRM Compass Point** one-on-one coaching plans—flexible to client needs—individual worksheets or chapters used as needed for specific skill areas.



Core Resources: 2 Pieces, All Applications Family Road Map Guide & Activity Booklet



- 100-page Family Road Map Guide used for all three applications
- Accompanying 28-page Activity Booklet contains worksheets and fill-in activity sheets
- Includes 5 “Guiding Star Point” chapters PLUS Guiding Star Focus chapter: The Classroom-Treatment Connection
- Final chapter: Glossary of common terms used in health, education & insurance systems; additional resources






A Flexible Curriculum and Training Format

- Adapts to unique community cultural needs (Trainer's Lesson Plan is a living, collaborative document)
- Includes multi-level Trainer/Facilitator achievement points (Facilitator to Master Trainer)
- TUFF/FRM Certified Trainers and Facilitators working in their own agencies and communities choose the appropriate format based on size of group, time constraints, physical space considerations, budget, etc.



*Certification training requires 3-9 hours of direct instruction and other requirements.

Core Concept: The Guiding Star



Guiding Star: Five essential tasks that keep a person oriented while navigating ANY system

Family Road Map: Organized around simple, step-by-step ways to navigate medical, behavioral, educational, and insurance systems *using all five points of the Guiding Star.*



Guiding Star Point 1: SET GOALS




“Decide what you're looking for based on the strengths and concerns of your child or youth, and your family (including yourself). Life is simpler when everyone on your team understands your child’s or youth's--and your family’s--priorities.”




Guiding Star Point 2: LEARN SYSTEM BASICS



“Become familiar with key words, procedures, and provider roles so you understand what choices you have, where to find services, and how to get those services.”




Guiding Star Point 3: BUILD RELATIONSHIPS




“Develop good working relationships with people who can help you meet your goals, bust system barriers, and solve problems.”



Guiding Star Point 4: MANAGE INFORMATION




“Keep good records. Observe and report on your child’s or youth's progress. Insist on getting clear explanations for any data (such as test scores) that will be used to make decisions.”



Guiding Star Point 5: FIND SUPPORT



“Find people and resources you can count on to help you cope with challenges and create the future you want for your family.”






Guiding Star Focus: The Classroom-Treatment Connection

- 2017 Material is revised for broadest national application by the TUFF Editorial Team





All 2014-2016 certified trainers are eligible to receive at no additional cost
